**MEDIA ALERT: ACTIVISTS, ASSEMBLE!** Progressive Activist Groups Rallying in **SHORELINE**

**On Monday April 17**, for the first time, the largest **Indivisible** groups in Washington state: **Indivisible North Seattle**, **Seattle Indivisible**, **Indivisible Eastside**, and **Puget Sound Indivisible** (with combined membership of over 10,000) are co-sponsoring an Indivisible Town Meeting during the April congressional recess. The goal is to empower citizens who are angry and frustrated about what's happening, but don't know how to fight back. The event will feature speakers and an "Activist Fair" in which attendees can learn how to use social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.) and other tools for social change. They will also learn how to contact Members of Congress, and network with other progressive activist groups.

The evening will include:

- **Seattle City Councilmember Kshama Sawant** speaking on the fight for Single Payer health care.
- **King County Councilmember Rod Dembowski** speaking on Protecting Puget Sound from the Trump EPA.
- **Expert speakers on other critical issues:** Immigrant Rights and Sanctuary Cities, Investigating Trump ties to Russia, Defeating Dave Reichert, Flipping the 45th LD, and more.
- **Activist Fair:** Easy, effective ways for attendees to take their activism to the next level, and network with other progressive activist groups.
